

How does MCCW accomplish its mission?:

MCCW is organized in five geographical regions which act as liaisons between the Worldwide Board and chapel groups.

MCCW offers an annual training program to help get new groups started, train new leadership, and orient women to the organization.

Chapel groups provide spiritually enriching programs, enabling women to minister to one another and the community.

Meeting Times:

Why does MCCW exist?:

Chapel level:
